E-Bike Club

WHAT: The DD Ebike Group will be traveling to Veyo, Utah, to ride on the brand-new bike lane that is completely separate from vehicle traffic. It is an easy, 12-mile round trip ride and there is an option of exploring the Baker Dam Campground to add a few extra miles. Linda Harris will be leading the October 11th hike in beautiful Kolob Canyons with Toni Swany as co-lead. Depending upon trail conditions at the time we will either hike an unnamed trail (1st choice) or Taylor Creek/Double Arch Alcove (2nd choice if we can't hike the unnamed trail). This hike is for stronger hikers. You should not sign up for this hike unless you can easily climb 6 to 8 flights of stairs, have no knee issues, and have good stamina. The trail is narrow, steep in some places, and littered with rocks. Some rock scrambling is required. The hike is only about 4 miles round trip but will take 4-6 hours to complete as we will take our time and enjoy the views. At the end of the hike, we are rewarded with a beautiful vertical canyon. This hike is limited to 12 hikers per Zion Park regulations. We need 3 volunteers to drive, and at least 3 riders with National Park passes.
