#### **MEMBERSHIP PAGE**

Constitutional Note - Article II - The purpose of the Club shall be to acquaint residents in the City of Mesquite and the surrounding areas and promote friendship through meetings, social functions and interest groups. This Club may not become involved in, or take any position on, political or religious issues.. The Club exists for the sole benefit of its members.

Article III Membership, Section 1 - The members of the Club shall be any persons over 21 years of age, regardless of race, color or creed, residing in the City of Mesquite and the surrounding areas. Section 2 - A prospective member may attend two (2) meetings, and one (1) interest group before paying dues. Only paid members and one (1) paying guest may participate in social functions. Only paid members may vote on Club issues.

**Article IV Dues, Section 2** - Any person two (2) months in arrears shall be dropped from the Club. A reinstatement fee of 5.00, plus dues, shall be paid to rejoin.


#### **January Meet and Greet**
